

Evaluation Criteria

Formative Assessment/ Summative Assessment for classes VI to X and Quarterly/ Half Yearly/Pre-Board/ Annual Examination for XI & XII.

1. There will no formal examination system for classes Prep.-I to II. The students will get promotion on the basis of Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment by the teachers.
2. It has been decided under the examination rules that there will no Re-assessment/Examination will be conducted for VI – XII. However Re-examination will be conducted for classes I to VIII for Formative Assessments only at the end of the session before Annual Assessment (SA-II). The amount of Rs. 100/- has to be paid for each Re-examination.
3. Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation is compulsory for all students. If any student remains absent in any assessment without prior permission of the Principal, Zero (0) mark will be marked in that particular subject.
4. New students will start appearing in the assessments after 15 days of their admission/joining the school.
5. Students who have been admitted after the assessment (s) or those who are on duty with the permission of Principal or those whose leave is sanctioned by Principal will be granted average marks.
6. Maximum Marks for **Formative Assessments will be of 25 Marks** for each subject for classes VI- X.
7. Maximum Marks for **Summative Assessments will be of 100 Marks** for each subject for classes VI- VIII.
8. There will be Monthly Test for classes XI & XII and the Maximum Marks will be 30, 35 & 35 for the First, Second & the Third test respectively.
9. As per the directive of CBSE, Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation system has been introduced in the year 2009 for class IX. The same now be as Mentioned below.

The students will have to obtain at least 25% of marks in Summative Assessment –II to qualify the exam. Otherwise (S) he will have to appear in improvement of performance exam even if (S) he has obtained more than 33% of marks in aggregate in all the assessments/exams.

*Those students who have qualifying grade (D and above) in all the subjects will be awarded a qualifying certificate and they shall be eligible for the admission in higher classes.

Those candidates who have obtained E1 of E2 will have to appear in improvement of performance test/ exam.

* Those students who have not obtained qualifying grade (D and above) in all the subjects as per the scheme of studies shall not be permitted for admission in higher classes.

Note:

As per the promotion criteria, a student must get 35% of marks in each subject and an aggregate 40%.

For class XI (Science Stream) there will be a practical exam in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, and Computer Science & Physical Education which will be assessed out of 30 marks.

- For class XI (Commerce Stream) there will be a project work in Business Studies and English which will be assessed out of 10 marks and 20 marks respectively.
- There will be a Practical in Accountancy which will be assessed out of 20 marks.
- For Environmental Science & G.K./General Studies one test will be conducted in each term and students must obtain 35% of marks for clear pass.
